



(Samples are based on techniques to make clothes)

Your days will be in a relaxed, clean and inspirational environment, working at your own pace in our professional sewing workroom. You will have access to our equipment during your time here & advice on their uses. You will receive first-hand small business advice, based on 35 years practical & 25 years teaching experience, on this specially designed course in Oxfordshire.

You will learn how to make an item in class under expert supervision, along with ongoing question & answers during your time in our Sewing Tuition workroom – do ask as many questions as you wish!

(Option of having an extra session prior to starting this course, if refreshing on a sewing machine needed)

After each day here, you will take home notes, manuals & your relevant sample. You will then have the notes to refer to, along with your sample to recap on, to enable you to make your replica piece at home, at your leisure. You will then bring it along to a later session for assessment when completed at home, which will then go towards your final certificate of your Dressmaking achievements at Sewing Tuition.

There will be opportunities to learn other techniques that will assist you with your journey whilst attending. Session times are 10am to 4pm for your small group, ‘one on one’ tuition.

We aim to help you achieve your goals, supporting you in-between your days in our workroom.
