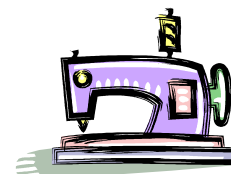

Welcome to the Sewing Tuition 10 day Certificate Course. This programme has been designed for those wishing to start their own small business whilst based at home or for personal achievement – the sessions are nicely spaced out, to fit in with your lifestyle. (Samples are based on the most popular used today)

Your days will be in a relaxed, clean and inspirational environment, working at your own pace in our professional sewing workroom. You will have access to our equipment during your time here & advice on their uses. You will receive first-hand small business advice, based on 35 years practical & 25 years teaching experience, on this especially designed course in Oxfordshire.

You will learn how to make an item in class under expert supervision, along with ongoing question & answers during your time in our Sewing Tuition workroom – do ask as many questions as you wish!

(Option of having an extra session prior to starting this course, if refreshing on a sewing machine needed)

2	Curtains – Regular Blackout		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How to measure • Estimate quantities • Calculate widths • Allow for turnings • Apply Blackout • Select & apply headings • Assemble pieces together

3	Hand Sewn Headings		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Calculate & Triple Pleat/Goblet headings • Apply buckram heading • Allow for hems & turnings • Finish off professionally
4	Hand Sewn Headings - continued		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Calculate & make Inverted Pleat heading • Allow for hems & turnings • Finish off professionally • Hang & dress the above
5	Lambrequins		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make your pattern • Cut out plywood accurately • Hinge the 'returns' • Pad out lambrequin face • Apply main fabric • Line & finish backing • Apply fixing to back
6	Lambrequins' - continued		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shape your pattern • Cut out plywood shape accurately • Hinge the 'returns' • Pad out shaped lambrequin face • Apply main fabric • Line & finish backing • Apply fixing to back
7	Headboards		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Decide on headboard shape • Cut out the base board • Cut & apply the foam • Apply the main fabric • Make a piped edge • Make a flat border & apply • Discuss different borders

8	Headboards		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Decide on headboard shape • Cut out the base board • Cut & apply the foam • Apply the main fabric • Make a roused border & apply • Discuss different borders • Complete an impressive 'Quarter size' double Headboard
9	Dining Chair Covers – Day 1		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Measure each section • Calculate fabric quantities • Allow for seams • Make & apply piping • Cut out quantities economically • Fit your chair cover • Select suitable fabrics • Adapt styles & look at ideas?
10	Dining Chair Covers – Day 2		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Measure each section • Calculate fabric quantities • Allow for seams • Make & apply piping • Fit your chair cover • Select suitable fabrics • Calculate for skirts where needed

You do not need to bring anything along – just your favourite sewing machine or use ours - as everything is included for you to complete your 'samples'. Based on past courses, learners have preferred to use our fabrics (included) for the first sample made here, and then use fabrics of your choice to make the second piece at home, so any adjustments can be discussed during class, ready to perfect your final piece.

After each day here, you will take home notes, manuals & your relevant sample. You will then have the notes to refer to, along with your sample to recap on, to enable you to make your replica piece at home, at your leisure. You will then bring it along to your next session for assessment, which will then go towards your final certificate of your achievements at Sewing Tuition.

There will be opportunities to learn other techniques that will assist you with your journey whilst attending. Session times are 10am to 4pm for your small group, 'one on one' tuition.

We aim to help you achieve your goals, supporting you in-between your days in our workroom.

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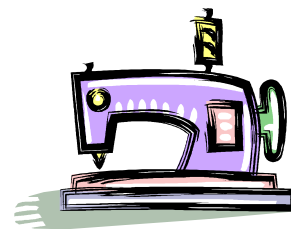
