Wednesday 6 th September	Regular Lined Curtain	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How to estimate fabric quantities • Calculate drops & widths • Pattern Matching • Allow for hems & turnings • Cut out square • Select & apply headings • Assemble pieces together • Gather up professionally
Thursday 7 th September	Cushions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Calculate fabric quantities • Allow for seams & turnings • Cut out accurately & square • Assemble pieces together • Inset a zip • Make piping
Friday 8 th September	Bags & Crafts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Basic bag with zips & pockets • Or assorted crafts to choose from

Saturday 9 th September	Overlocker	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rethread the EASY way • Rolled hems • Gather fabric • Neaten raw edges professionally • Twiddle the knobs with confidence • Use threads for decorative effects • Change the colours with great effect • Use Decorative threads
Sunday 10 th September		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check out from hotel by 11am
